

***SUBSTANTIA* Award for a Young Scientist**

"***Substantia***. *An International Journal of the History of Chemistry*" (the hereafter "journal") is an open access peer-reviewed academic journal dedicated to traditional perspectives as well as innovative and synergetic implications of Chemistry. The journal hosts discussions on the connections between chemistry and other scientific disciplines (physics, mathematics, life and earth sciences, etc.) and also with other horizons of human activities. The journal is edited by the Department of Chemistry of the University of Florence, Italy.

The "European Colloid and Interface Science Society" (the hereafter "ECIS") is a non-profit society of scientists, devoted to the advancement of Colloid and Interface Science and particularly to the support of young scientists, in collaboration with national societies in European countries and with other international organizations. ECIS is registered in Mainz, Germany. Every year in early September, ECIS holds an annual meeting in a European location, with the active participation of several young scientists.

With these premises, the journal and ECIS

AGREE


upon the creation of the "***Substantia Award***" for the best oral contribution presented by a young scientist at the annual meeting of ECIS. The award consists in the amount of € 500,00 that are transferred to the winner directly.

The journal and ECIS agree also on the following guidelines:

1) By "young scientist" it is meant a person that possesses a M.Sc degree and has

been actively performing scientific research for a period of time shorter than the PhD plus 1 year.

2) The applicants will declare their intention to compete for the award along with the submission of the abstract of their contribution.

3) The decision will be taken during the annual meeting by a special Committee including:

one representative of the journal's Editorial Board

one representative of the ECIS Board

one member of the local organizing Committee

two representatives selected from the invited speakers and the International Scientific Committee of the annual meeting.

4) The journal will transfer the amount of € 500,00 to ECIS every year, before July 15. ECIS will transfer the money to the winner within one month after the end of the annual meeting.

5) The present agreement lasts for three years and will be renewed by tacit agreement unless one of the parties notifies the written intention to withdraw, no later than November 30 of each year.
